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Introduction

JV North is a successful, long-standing consortium of housing association and local authority members that work together to build high-quality, affordable homes. In 2024, the consortium passed the notable milestone of building 10,000 homes.

In doing so, members have now housed in the region of 30,000 people across the North West and with Homes England, invested over £1 billion.

We are building on this success with members as ambitious as always in playing a key role addressing the housing crisis.

Central to this sees consortium members currently managing a development pipeline of over 4,000 properties in Homes England's 2021/26 Affordable Homes Programme.

Partnerships are at the heart of our approach. We know from experience that when we work closely together with stakeholders we deliver more by maximising outcomes better.

A key example is the launch of our fourth contractors' and consultants' framework to help members build homes local people urgently need.

Valued at £500m and running for four years, it is open to our full members and can also be accessed by other social housebuilders as 'procurement members' via a one-year membership option.

By adopting the Building Back Fairer principle and taking united action, we want to rebuild our communities to provide more homes while simultaneously addressing inequalities, poor health and unemployment.

As well as benefiting from economies of scale when bidding for Homes England grant, JV North members enjoy an array of added value benefits to aid their development programmes.

Examples include sharing market intelligence and data; programme delivery insight from Homes England via our development and programme management consultant Saffer Cooper; running investigative pilot projects; and, managing a benchmarking club so analysis can aid decision-making.

We regularly accept new members with likeminded organisations always welcome to join us and help build more homes.

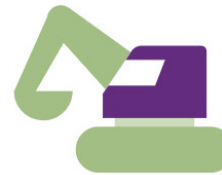

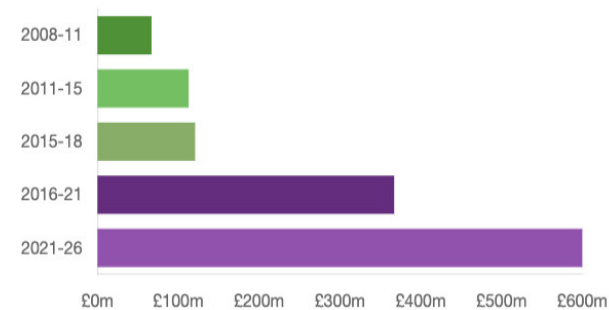

- c. 30 x individual contractors to deliver in the region of 3,000 homes
- Estimated construction value: £475Million
- Estimated Consultant fees: £20Million
- Operational from 1st August 2025
- Keen focus on SME contractors
